STAGE 1

Introduction into Vertical Reference Flying

Stage 1 is an introduction to Vertical Reference flying, 5 hours:

- 2 1/2 hours pad work Vertical Reference
- 2 1/2 hours on heliports
- Related ground instruction
- Stage check and evaluation

Upon completion of Stage 1, training pilots will have a basic understanding of Vertical Reference techniques and be able to demonstrate proficiency in operating from makeshift heliports.

STAGE 2

Introduction into Longline Flying

Stage 1 is an introduction to the basics of Longline flying, 5 hours:

- Introduction to the basics of Longline flying
- Related ground instruction
- Stage check and evaluation

Upon completion of Stage 2, training pilots will have an understanding of Longlining concepts and techniques.

STAGE 3

Advanced Proficiency in Longlining Techniques

Stage 3 is Advanced Proficiency Longlining, with a maximum of 10 hours:

- Show advanced proficiency in Longline techniques (including sling load simulations)
- Related ground instruction

Upon completion of Stage 3, training pilots will have met the minimum standards for Advanced Longline Proficiency
